

# ***MINISTRY REVIEW SHEET***

## ***EXTRAORDINARY MINISTERS OF HOLY COMMUNION***

The Ministry Review sheet is a suggested resource that may need to be adapted further to be relevant to particular ministries.

This resource is offered as an example of gauging how Extraordinary Ministers of the Holy Communion are feeling about their ministry, and if support is needed or changes are needed.

### ***God***

As an Extraordinary Minister of the Holy Communion has your faith and love of God in any way changed because of your commitment to your ministry?  
If, so how?

### ***Church***

As an Extraordinary Minister of the Holy Communion has your appreciation of the Church generally in any way altered?  
If, so how?

### ***Priest***

As an Extraordinary Minister of the Holy Communion has your relationship towards your parish priest(s) in any way changed?  
If, so how?

### ***Parish***

As an Extraordinary Minister of the Holy Communion has your understanding of parishioners developed in any way?  
If, so how?

## ***Marriage***

Has being an Acolyte / Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion / Altar Server affected the relationship with your spouse in any way? If so, how?

## ***Family***

As an Extraordinary Minister of the Holy Communion on the sanctuary, and so not sitting in the congregation with your family, has this affected your relationship with them in any way? If so, how?

## ***Support***

Are there areas in your ministry where you feel you need more support or formation? If so, how and what?

## ***Continuance***

Do you wish to *continue* in the *active* ministry of the Extraordinary Minister of the Holy Communion and why?

## ***Discontinuance***

Do you wish to *discontinue* in the *active* ministry of the Extraordinary Minister of the Holy Communion and why?

## ***Further Concerns***

Are there any other issues and concerns you have about being an Extraordinary Minister of the Holy Communion? If so, what?
