**THE LITURGICAL YEAR IN SONG-
THE SEASON OF EASTER (YEAR B)**



INTRODUCTION

This booklet, is the third in the series *The Liturgical Year In Song*. This third volume begins on the Second Sunday of Easter and goes through each Sunday up and until and including Pentecost Sunday.

During this Season of joy, we celebrate the Resurrection of Jesus for fifty days. That means fifty days of 'Alleluia', festive music, and Easter eggs. The Paschal candle has a prominent place during the Easter Season and is lit at every liturgy for the fifty days of this Season. The constant lighting of the Paschal Candle reminds us that Christ is our beginning and our end, and the Light that we follow and in turn sustains us in our lives.

As with the previous volume, this Easter Volume draws on various sources and includes music that will be suitable for children as well. There are some Sundays where the hymns are specific to the readings of the Sunday (for example on the Fourth Sunday of Easter we celebrate Good Shepherd Sunday). There will be other Easter hymns that are suitable throughout the Easter Season. Also, as with the two previous volumes, in keeping with good liturgical practice, the heading at the start of each Sunday contains, the colour of the day. I have also included a brief commentary on the readings of the day, which I hope will be helpful. In addition, I have included pictures to illustrate the main focus for each of the Sundays. With the exception of the image on the front cover, all other images have been taken from *Sharefaith*, and are reprinted under permission. The picture on the front cover is our Paschal candle here at the Centre for Liturgy. I always like to include pictures as I think they make the resource more aesthetically pleasing and in turn more appealing to people to use the resource.

Where possible, indications have been made as to which antiphon or reading the suggested hymn relates to for that particular Sunday. In some instances, hymns relate to the Responsorial Psalm. Whilst the hymn may relate to or be based on the Psalm for that particular day, it may not follow the Psalm exactly in the Lectionary, and therefore should be used as a hymn during the Mass, rather than replace the Responsorial Psalm.

My suggestion for this Easter Season, is to choose one new hymn (two at the most) and use it throughout this Eastertide. You need to repeat it a few times, and these seven weeks of Easter will afford you the opportunity to do so. There are ample suggestions in this resource, and music that is suitable for both children and adults.

So, as we hear on Easter Sunday: 'This is the day, the Lord has made, let us rejoice and be glad!' May our music selections and the presentation of them in our liturgies during this Easter Season reflect our thanksgiving to the Lord for all that he has done for us.

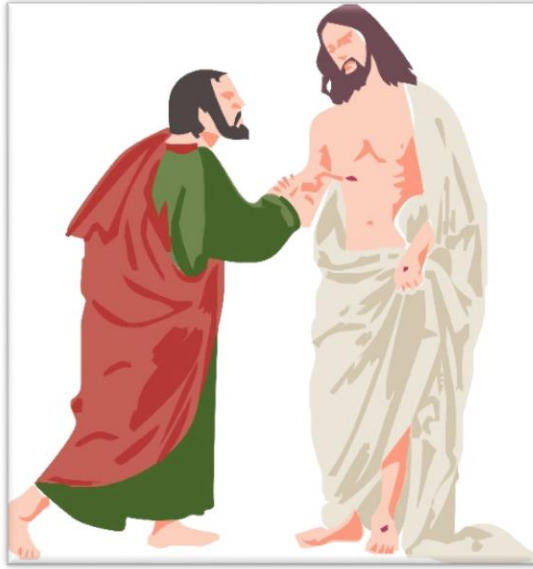

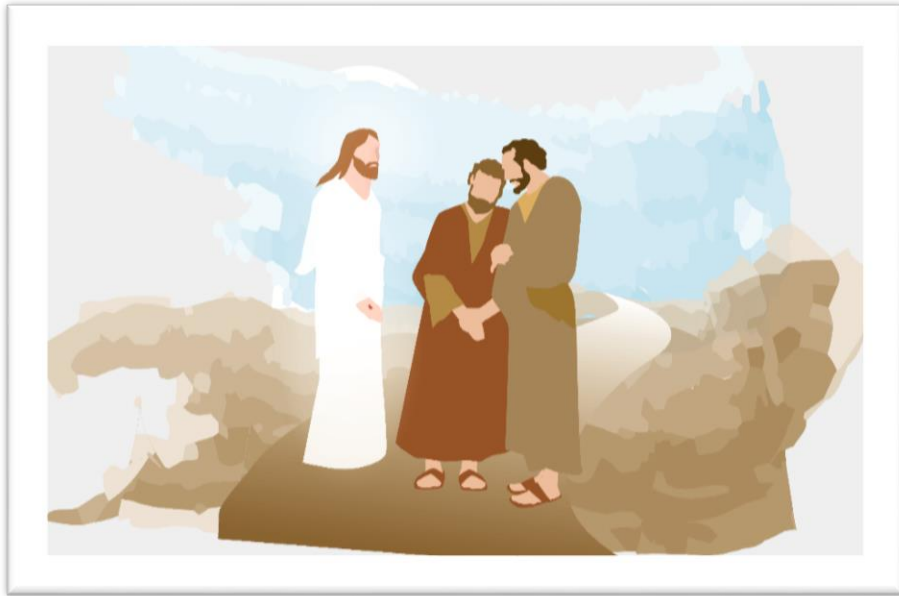

Third Sunday of Easter - Year B

Introductory comment

In the Gospel reading today, we hear the story of Emmaus. This story is a reminder to us, that the Eucharist is the "source and summit" of our Catholic Faith, and that the Sunday Mass, should be the 'high point' of each parish community for the week, for that is the weekly gathering of the parish as a faith community. So, just as the disciples recognized Jesus 'in the breaking of the Bread', hopefully people will see Christ in us, and be encouraged to join us in our work of faith.

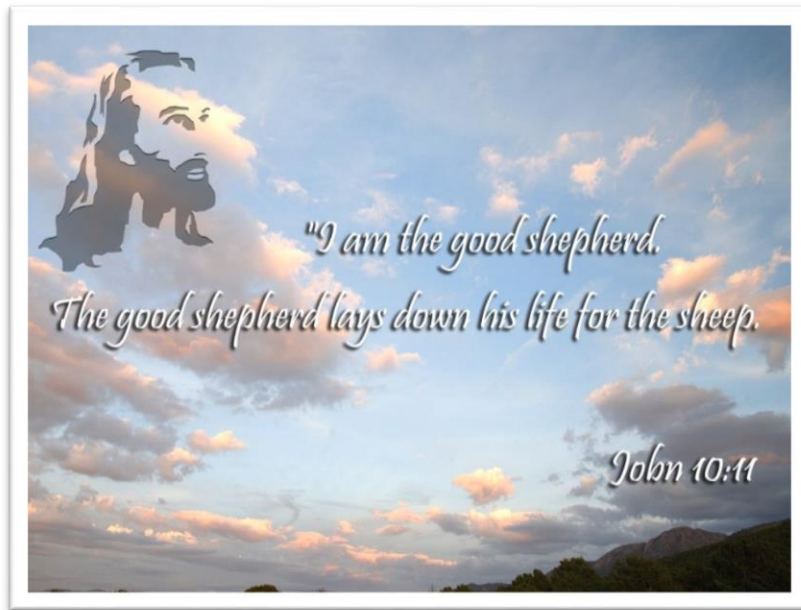

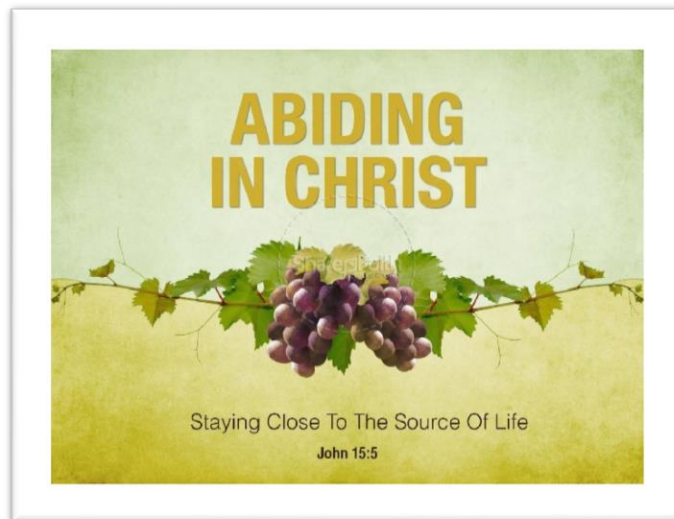

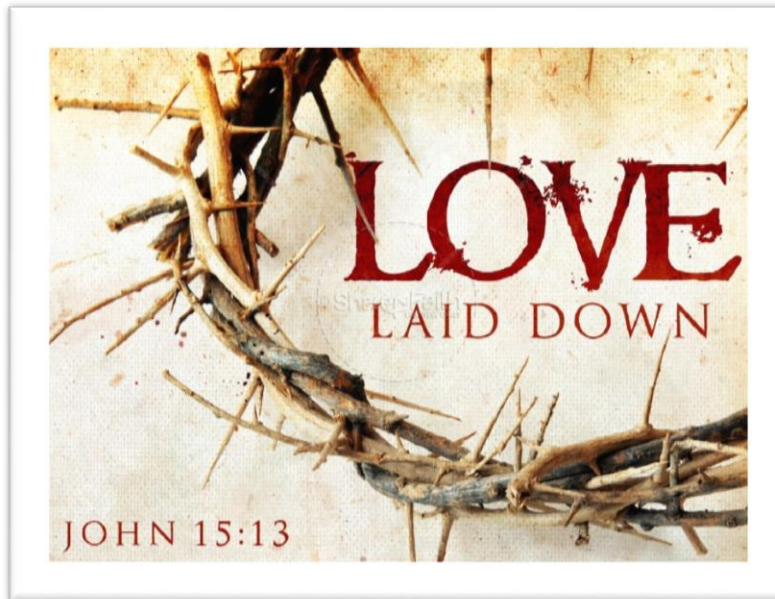

Sixth Sunday of Easter - Year B

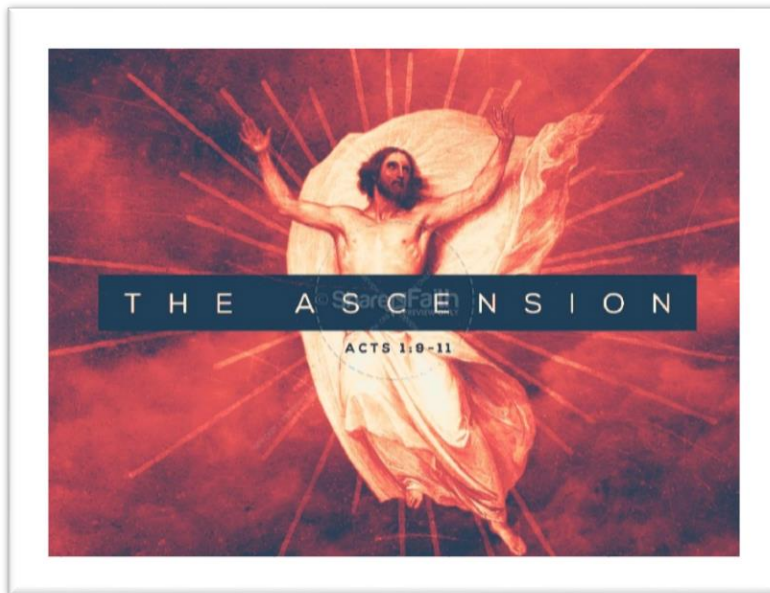

Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord - Pear B

Introductory comment

Today we celebrate the Ascension of the Lord and as this is a Solemnity, we have returned to the gold border. For many years now, we have celebrated this feast on a Sunday (transferred from the Thursday). There are so many topics one could write about for this feast. I am going to touch on two. Firstly, in the First Reading (Acts 1:11) today, we hear (the following):

“Men of Galilee,

why are you standing there looking at the sky?

This Jesus who has been taken up from you into heaven

will return in the same way as you have seen him going into heaven.”

The Apostles were totally confused. Jesus had gone up to heaven and they didn’t know what to do. Sometimes we can be like them, starrng into the sky. That really is a waste of our time. For the Lord needs us to be doing his work on earth. He needs us to be (in the words of Saint Teresa of Avila): His hands, feet, eyes, his Body on earth. There are two important elements to our faith. Prayer and action. One can’t happen without the other. You will notice that I have made a musical suggestion to the Saint Teresa text, which would be suitable to use on this Ascension Sunday.

In the Gospel, Jesus tells his disciples (and us) to go and proclaim His Gospel on the earth. We can only do that by prayer and action, not by ‘starrng into the sky’.

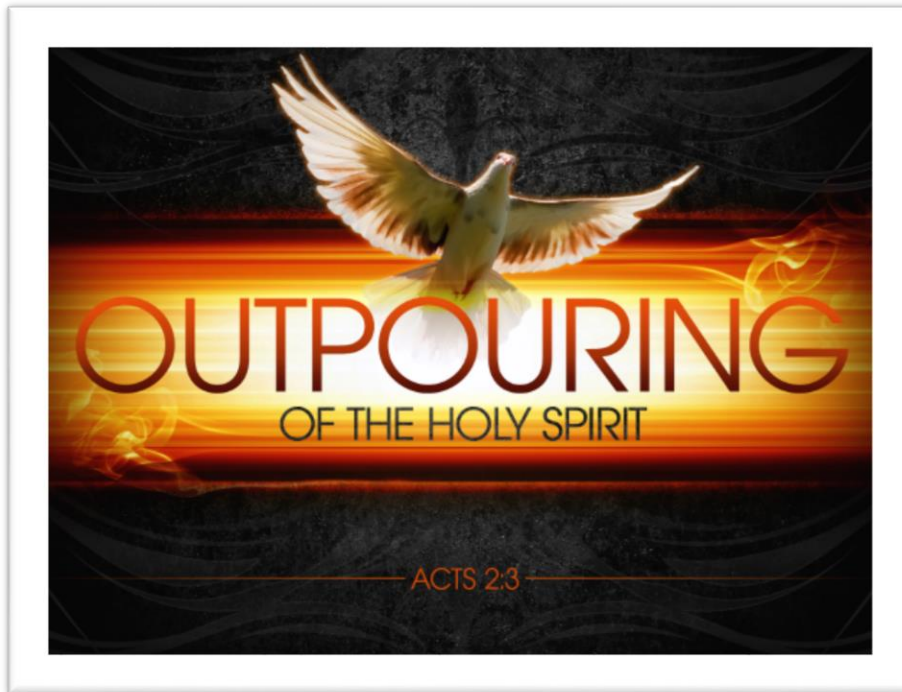
