Sprinkling of Ashes

- The people wear masks during the distribution of the Ashes.
- Gentle music could be played as the Ashes are distributed.
- Cleanse your hands before the distribution of the Ashes.
- Invite people to move forward to receive Ashes.
- Encourage social distancing as they come forward.
- Once a person is in front of you take some of the ashes and sprinkle it over their head without saying anything.
