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Ideas on how to use the Children's Activity Sheet.

There are 40 days in Lent. Each week's days can be coloured in along with the image relating to the Sunday of Lent. The special colour used for Lent is purple. This colour reminds us to think of the things we may do wrong and to say sorry to God.

Each week when you are listening to the story about Jesus (Gospel) at Mass find out the answers to the questions and fill these in the squares.

Week One

Jesus went out into the desert.

Do you know how many days he was gone?

- Place the number of days in squares [days] 3 and 4.

Week Two

Jesus climbed to the top of a high mountain with his friends and something special happened.

- Jesus called the person who spoke about him from the cloud by a special name.

This name has 6 letters in it. In the spaces for days 5-10 write in the name Jesus called God?

Week Three

Jesus was very thirsty, and he asked someone for a drink of water.

Who was it he asked?

Write the answer in days 12-16.



Week Four

A blind man was given back his sight by Jesus. Jesus made a paste and put it on the man's eyes.

- He then told the man to do something? The man went away and did what Jesus asked,
write what he did down in days 22-17.

Week Five

A friend of Jesus dies, and Jesus brings him back to life.

- What was the name of the man who died? Use days 23-28 (place two letters in day 28).

Week Six

Jesus rode a donkey and people sang songs of praise to him.

- What is the special name of this Sunday? Write it in days 29-33.
