## Liturgical Ministry Revisit and Review 2022

Dear Friends,

I hope you are well and managing the twists and turns of 2022 with Covid-19 upon us.

Over the past twelve months the staff at the Centre for Liturgy have been conducting both face to face and online ministry training workshops.

Given the developing situation with Covid-19 in Perth the Centre for Liturgy will hold all workshops online using Zoom for the next three months and then review the health risks of returning to face-to-face workshops as well as continuing the online sessions.

Parishes have responded to online workshops very well. Where parishioners have struggled to navigate the online experience, support has come from different areas. Centre for Liturgy Field Officers are always happy to help participants negotiate the online experience with practice sessions on how to use Zoom before the actual workshop is conducted.

The workshops will be shorter to help alleviate fatigue setting in when sitting for long periods of time in front of a computer screen and will be conducted over two sessions where necessary.

- Proclaimers of the Word - Wednesday 30 March

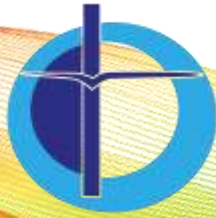
### Liturgical Ministry Revisit and Review 2022 Resources

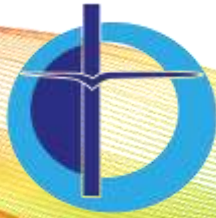
