


#### PRESENTER

#### PRESENTER

A reading from the Gospel according to Luke Then he took a loaf of bread, and when he had given thanks he broke it and gave it to them, saying, "This is my body, which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of me." And he did the same with the cup after supper, saying, "This cup that is poured out for you is the new covenant in my blood."

#### PRESENTER

A reading from the first letter of St Paul to the Corinthians

For I received from the Lord what I also passed on to you: The Lord Jesus, on the night he was betrayed, took bread, and when he had given thanks, he broke it and said, 'This is my body, which is for you; do this in remembrance of me.' In the same way, after supper he took the cup, saying, 'This cup is the new covenant in my blood; do this, whenever you drink it, in remembrance of me.' For whenever you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes.

#### PRESENTER

In St Paul's letter we hear that the memorial of the Last Supper is not simply calling to mind an event but that the liturgical celebration of the Eucharist makes Jesus present.

He could also say to us, "This is my sacrifice ... this is the making present of my offering to the Father for love of you: Do this in memory of me

Allow yourself to be united to my offering as you enter into the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. Make your own offering in union with mine, so that I may take it for you to the Father." PRESENTER Read from slide

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At the Last Supper Christ instituted the Paschal Sacrifice and banquet, by which the Sacrifice of the Cross is continuously made present in the Church whenever the priest, representing Christ the Lord, carries out what the Lord himself did and handed over to his disciples to be done in his memory. [GIRM 72]




#### PRESENTER

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


The Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy published by Vatican II outlines the way in which Jesus is present.




Christ is present in the sacrifice of the Mass click He is **present in the person of His minister**, "the same now offering, through the ministry of priests, who formerly offered himself on the cross, but click He is present especially under the Eucharist species. By his power He is present in the sacraments, so that when a man baptizes it is really Christ Himself who baptised. click He is present in the Word, since it is He himself who speaks when the holy scriptures are read in the Church. He is present lastly, click He is present when the Church prays and sings, for He promised: "When two or three are gathered in my name, there am I in the midst of them" Matt. 18:20 (SC#7) Let us now look a little further at the four presences of Jesus in the Eucharist as outlined in the Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy.





By the calling down of the Holy Spirit in the Eucharistic Prayer the bread and wine are transformed into the Body and Blood of Jesus. By our partaking of Jesus' Body and Blood, we too are transformed into the Body of Christ.

In the words of the Eucharistic Prayer the Church implores the power of the Holy Spirit that the gifts offered by human hands be consecrated; that is become Christ's Body and Blood. *Read from slide*

The Eucharistic presence, Jesus, calls forth from each of us the presence of God within and creates a longing that only God can fulfill.


The challenge is more than simply recognizing and receiving the presence of Jesus. It is remembering God within and desiring to grow closer to God.
