INTRODUCTION

During September we held the Music Reading Course – Part II. The course was attended by six participants, most of whom had completed Music Reading Course – Part I. In the first session of the course, the material about the names of the notes, note values, rests and key signatures which was covered in the first part of the Course was reviewed. In the following weeks, the new topics that were covered included dotted and tied notes, triplets, accidentals, key signatures and major scales. Well done to all who participated in the course!

In last month's Newsletter, I began looking at how Gregorian Chant can be used in a parish setting so that the requirements of *Sacrosanctum Concilium* can be fulfilled. I listed the parts of the Mass that form the Ordinary of the Mass. This month I have listed music that is suitable for the Holy Week liturgies. Next month I will list some Gregorian Chant hymns that are in CWB II that you can include in your parish's repertoire.

In the Music Suggestions lists, I have included Music suggestions for October and November. The November suggestions include suitable music suggestions for the Solemnity of All Saints on Wednesday 1 November and also All Souls' Day on Thursday 2 November. There are some points to note with the music for All Souls' Day and these are included at the end of the music list for All Souls' Day on page 25 of this Newsletter. Yes, time is marching on, and we will soon be celebrating the season of Advent – marking the start of a new liturgical year, hence our workshop on music for Advent and Christmas being held on Monday 23 October. Speaking of Advent, at the end of this Newsletter, Chris and I have included four hymns for the Sundays of Advent. The refrain is the same for each week, but the verses change for each Sunday. We offer this text and tune as part of the various threads that make up the tapestry of liturgical music. (See pages 33-44.)

WORKSHOPS OCTOBER-NOVEMBER 2023

The workshops planned for October and November 2023 are as follows:

16. Music for Advent and Christmas

-Monday 23 October

This workshop will explore music resources for the Advent and Christmas Seasons (including the Feast of the Holy Family, January 1 – Mary, Mother of God and the Epiphany). It will equip participants with print music for the Advent and Christmas Seasons and direct them to on-line resources that can be accessed readily. During this workshop, the Christmas Proclamation and the Epiphany Proclamation will be taught.

17. Copyright II (this workshop is a repeat of the copyright workshops held earlier this year)

-Thursday 9 November

Churches and church musicians are not exempt from copyright law. This workshop will explore what falls under copyright and what doesn't, what licenses are required to reproduce text and music, the process for applying for a license with OneLicense and the requirements of each of these licenses.

The workshops will comply with the COVID-safe regulations that apply at the time.

REFLECTION

116. The Church acknowledges Gregorian chant as specially suited to the Roman liturgy: therefore, other things being equal, it should be given pride of place in liturgical services.

What does the preceding paragraph from *Sacrosanctum Concilium* mean?

This month's reflection on *Sacrosanctum Concilium* continues looking at how Gregorian Chant can be used in a parish setting and perhaps where the musical resources and experience may be limited.

Last month, I listed the chants that form the Ordinary of the Mass which could be used in a parish setting.

This month, I am going to look at some other pieces of Gregorian Chant music from CWB II that can be incorporated into a parish music program.

There are also the various dialogue responses in the Mass from *The Roman Missal* which are contained in this book as well. For example, "The Lord be with you." "And with your spirit."

There are Gregorian Chant melodies in the Holy Week liturgies contained in *The Roman Missal* which we can and should use.

Palm Sunday:

-Antiphon at the Blessing of the Palms: Hosanna to the Son of David (#302)

Holy Thursday:

-Procession to the Altar of Repose: Sing my tongue, the Saviour's glory / *Pange lingua gloriosi* (#315/316)

Good Friday:

-Showing of the Holy Cross (#319)

-Veneration of the Cross: Faithful Cross the Saints rely on (#321)

Holy Saturday:

-Easter Alleluia (#334)

-Litany of the Saints (CWB II #336)

-Easter Dismissal (CWB II #339/340)

Easter Sunday:

-Sequence: Christians, praise the Paschal Victim (CWB II #344)

-Easter Dismissal (CWB II #339/340)

The melodies mentioned above are very simple and use a great deal of repetition to help people learn and remember them. They can also be sung without accompaniment. So even if you do not have an accompanist, you can sing these melodies with ease.

If you would like some assistance with learning these melodies, please do not hesitate to contact me (see page 45 of this Newsletter), and Chris and I will be happy to organize a time for a workshop to teach them to you. You may even like to invite musicians from your neighboring parishes to come along as well.


